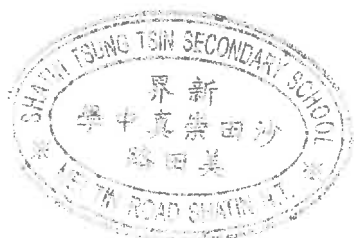

Participating in aesthetic interest groups or music classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Except Recital Groups, there is a quota for each group/team and students need to undergo screening.➤ Regarding aesthetic interest groups, there are around 12 lessons, each of which lasts 1.5 hours➤ Teachers-in-charge will evaluate students’ performance with respect to their attendance and involvement, etc.➤ Details of these activities (e.g. time, venue and fee etc.) can be found in the school notice (1819/003) or the webpage of the Extra-curricular Activities Committee of the school.
3. Participating in the Chinese / English / Putonghua Recital Groups	
4. Participating in school music teams

7. Music courses	➤ The course should take place between September 2018 and June 2019.	➤ Students have to get application forms from Ms. Chan Fung Yi or Mr. Tsang Shing Wai on or before 5 th September, 2018.
8. Arts courses	➤ There should be at least 10 lessons, each of which lasts at least 1.5 hours	
9. Other courses	➤ Students should keep their attendance records ➤ Students should submit relevant certificates or transcripts to the school for verification after completing the courses
